Assistance filling out the form

You can use three types of bank account. Choose the option that applies to you: Norwegian bank account, foreign bank account with IBAN, or a foreign bank account with an address.

An account in a Norwegian bank: An account number is a number that identifies a bank account number and is comprised of 11 digits.

Foreign account with IBAN: You much provide IBAN for payment to European banks, as well as certain banks in countries outside of Europe. IBAN begins with a country code with two large letters without a space. If you provide IBAN, you must also provide the banks BIC/SWIFT code. Your bank will be able to provide you with the IBAN and BIC/SWIFT codes.

Foreign bank without IBAN, with address: If you have a foreign bank account without IBAN, the banks address and bank code must be provided. The code is different from country to country.
